The paper entitled "Risk Averse Investment Strategies in a Carbon Constrained Environment," of **Dr. Semra Ağralı**, from the Department of Industrial Engineering, has been accepted for publication in Journal of the Operational Research Society. In this study, which is a joint work with Dr. Ethem Çanakoğlu and Esra Adıyeke from Bahçeşehir University, they develop a time consistent multi-stage stochastic optimization model for an investment problem of a private electricity generating company that plans to enter a partially regulated market that operates under an active cap and trade system. This study was supported by TUBITAK under grant 114M358.
